Dear colleagues!

On October 11, 2024 Shakarim University of Semey together with Ch.Ch. Valikhanov Institute of History and Ethnology holds an International scientific and practical conference on the topic **«Relations between the Kazakh and Dzungarian Khanate in the second half of the XVII – middle of the XVIII centuries»**.

The purpose of the conference – analysis of the history of relations between the Kazakh and Dzungar peoples in the period from the second half of the XVII century to the middle of the XVIII century, diplomatic and political interactions between the Kazakh and Dzungar Khanate.

Directions of the conference:

- ✓ analysis of documents and researches related to Kazakh-Dzungarian relations in the second half of the XVII – 50s of the XVIII centuries;
- ✓ analysis of diplomatic and political interactions between the Kazakh and Dzungarian Khanate;
- ✓ coverage of the Batyr Institute in the Kazakh-Dzungarian confrontation,
- ✓ study of dynastic marriages between Kazakh khans, sultans and Dzungarian rulers;
- ✓ research of the process of incorporation of Dzungars into Kazakh society;
- ✓ research of economic relations between Kazakhs and Dzungars;
- ✓ research of Dzungarian toponymy on the territory of Kazakhstan.

Conference participants: scientists, educators, experts, employees of research institutes, university teachers, doctoral students, master's students.

Working languages of the conference: Kazakh, Russian, English

The conference will be followed by a **compilation of materials**. There is no charge for the publication of materials.

Requirements for the design of submitted materials

- format – A4 page;
- text editor – Word 6.0 (7.0);
- font – Times New Roman, Kz Times New Roman;
- character size – 12 pt.;
- line spacing – single;
- margins – top, bottom, left, right – 20 mm;
- text alignment to line width;
- mandatory installation of automatic word wrapping;
- indent at the beginning of the paragraph – standard (1.25 cm);
- it is not allowed to use tabs or spaces to indent the first line;
- it is not allowed to use spaces to align the text (all words of the main text should be separated from each other by no more than one space);
- figures and graphs should have a clear image and be in black and white (black shading may be used);
- separate cells of tables should be highlighted in gray (black) color only if the tone carries a semantic load.

Thesis layout scheme

- At the top on the left side of the page is the MRNTI code (International Rubricator of Scientific and Technical Information). You can get the MRNTI code for the article at WWW.GRNTI.RU
- In the center – initials and surname of the author **in bold** (for each author – first initials, then surname).
- On the next line – the name of the organization, alignment in the center.
- On the next line – country, city, email address, center alignment.
- After a space – the title of the report **IN CAPITAL LETTERS in bold**, center alignment.
- Text of theses: width alignment. If it is necessary to emphasize a part of the text, **bold**, *italics* and underline are used.

- List of literature – items are numbered as references, format according to GOST 7.1-2003. In the text, references to literature are formalized by paragraph numbers in square brackets with a comma or a dash: [1], [2, 3], [1-4].
